Tamanu Beach was very lucky and other than truckloads of trees and rubbish and our fence pushed over we managed to escape the worst of Cyclone Pat.

Sadly for many of the people of Aitutaki this was not the case, we have lost many homes certainly more than 50 and many others damaged. Of our staff, we lost 3 homes with another 9 homes damaged. Everyone is safe and there were no injuries.

Our challenge now is to bounce back as quickly as possible and already you will be amazed at the rate the clean up and restoration of services has happened with very few resources. Many of you have asked what can we do.....well there are many things but perhaps most important is to remember that the Aitutaki you know and love is still here and very much wishes to welcome you back sometime soon.
